Produced from 100% organic materials (cornstalks and wood mulch), Compost-A-Mat[®] can be composted or broken into pieces and fed to gestating sows as feedback material to further protect the upcoming litters.

Farrowing mats are designed to last 7-21 days depending on the type used. Nursery and wean to finish mats are designed to last up to 21 days and can be discarded after use.
